

■ Do not connect the power adapter when product installation is incomplete. When carrying the product, please disconnect the power adapter.

(Otherwise, electric shock or injury may occur.)

■ Do not connect and disconnect the power adapter with wet hands. (Otherwise, electric shock may occur.)



■ Do not use power other than the rated voltage.


(Otherwise, the power adapter may be overheated and induce fire.)

■ Do not place or use flammable materials or aerosol cans near the electric fan.

■ Do not put the electric fan in water or pour water on it.

Do not expose the electric fan to open flames such as gas stoves, places containing flammable gases or aerosol cans, and places with rain or splashes, high temperature, high humidity, a lot of oil, dust and metal powder.

OPERATING REQUIREMENTS


- Make sure that the product is placed on a flat and stable floor.
- Make sure that the electric outlet is near the electric fan for easy access.
- Please always place the power adapter properly to prevent tripping.






HOW TO INSTALL

- Installation of Floor Fan
- 1) Rotate to connect the fan head assembly with the column.
- (2) Rotate to connect the column with the base



■ Installation of Table Fan Rotate to connect the fan head module with the base




■ While using the product, make sure that the column and the base module are tightly assembled.

(Otherwise, the product is easily turned over and results in injury.)

OPERATING METHOD


■ Control panel



Note:

- The display screen will automatically turn off if no operation on the fan. You can press any button to reactivate it.
- When the electric fan is running, it will turn to standby mode at around 24 hours of no operation automatically.
- In standby mode, the electric fan is still powered on, but not running.

■ Remote control




• You can use 1 remote control for multiple electric fans.

OPERATING METHOD

- Replacement of Remote Control Battery
- It is necessary to replace the battery when the remote control's performance reduces and the range decreases.
- If the battery is not handled properly, failure or injury may occur due to battery damage or liquid leakage.
- While the battery is placed in the remote control during factory shipment for testing purposes, its service life may be shortened due to self-discharge.
- Do not use batteries other than those specified.
- *CR2025 available in the market is recommended.

Battery installation: as shown in the figure, press the buckle and pull out the battery cover in the direction of the arrow. After placing the battery on the battery cover with the mark "+" facing upward, close the cover.



- When the battery leaks, avoid direct skin contact with the battery, and dispose the battery.
- Please comply with local laws and regulations when dispose the battery.
- Operation of Electric Fan

Standby/On





Product Remote control control panel

- Press this button to turn on the electric fan while it is in standby mode, and press this button to put the electric fan in standby mode while it is running. The electric fan runs at the default speed setting of level 3 without swing upon first startup.
- When power is disconnected, the electric fan will start at the default speed setting of level 3 without swing.

Speed setting





Product Remote control control panel

- Short press: Switchover.
- Long press: Speed up the speed setting shifting (applicable to the product control panel only, not the remote control).
- *The electric fan has 12 levels. It is suitable for various modes of operation.

OPERATING METHOD

Mode switch



Remote control

With each press on the button of the remote control, the mode changes in this sequence:

"Normal \rightarrow CF (Natural) \rightarrow SL (Sleepy)" and start over.

Normal	The electric fan keeps running at the level set currently (the LED display screen indicates the current level).				
CF (Natural) The speed changes according to the set level.					
SL (Sleeping)	The electric fan runs at the level set currently, reducing one level every 30 minutes, with a minimum speed of level 1.				

Scheduled standby timer To be set in power-on mode





Product Remote control control panel In power-on mode, press the "Timer" button to set a scheduled standby timer.

The timer can be adjusted in 1-hour increments, with a maximum of 8 hours, and can be set to repeat. "0 H" indicates that no timer is set.

Once the standby timer is set, the display screen will return to the normal level display, or show "CF" or "SL" after about 5 seconds of no operation. When the "Timer" button is pressed again, the display screen shows the current timer setting. Upon reaching the scheduled standby time, the electric fan enters the standby mode.

Scheduled power-on timer





Product control panel Remote control In standby mode, press the "Timer" button to set a scheduled power-on timer.

In the scheduling setting, the electric fan is set to run at level 3 without swing by default. The setting can be adjusted via the remote control or button on the panel. After the scheduled power-on timer is set, the display screen will show the current scheduled time after about 5 seconds of no operation.

When the scheduled power-on timer is set, you can press the "Standby/On" button to cancel the setting and power the electric fan immediately, and then it will run at level 3 without swing by default.

*When the scheduled timer is working, the display screen shows the remaining time (countdown).




The product can only be manually adjusted upward and downward. When adjusting, make sure the up-and-down module is adjusted in the direction indicated in the figure as shown.



MAINTENANCE



- Turn off the product and unplug the power adapter, let the product cool down, then use a screwdriver tool (to be purchased separately) to rotate the guard set screws at the guard bottom counterclockwise, and remove the screws.
- Rotate the front guard with your hands to align the sign" I" on the front guard with the unlock sign" → " on the rear guard.



- Disassemble the front guard → blade lock nut → blade → rear guard lock nut → rear guard as shown in the figure above, clean the components, and install them when they are fully dried.
- The installation sequence is reversed to the disassembly sequence.
- *When installing, it needs to align the sign" I" on the front guard with the sign" I" on the rear guard, then rotate the front guard clockwise to align the sign" I" on the front guard with the sign" △" on the rear guard.

MAINTENANCE


- Before cleaning and maintenance, make sure to unplug the power adapter and disconnect the power. Let the electric fan cool down before cleaning.
- Do not use chemical solvents such as toluene, bleach, or alcohol, or hard brushes to wipe, as this may scratch and corrode the appearance of the electric fan.
- If there are stains or stubborn dirt that cannot be easily removed, it is recommended to use kitchen-specific neutral cleaner and wipe them off with a soft dry cloth.
- It is recommended to regularly check and clean the product to extend its service life.
- Maintenance before Storage
- 1. Position the electric fan to face forward, and disassemble it in reversed order to the installation sequence provided in the manual. For detailed installation instructions, please refer to page 7 of the manual.
- 2. Do not manually reposition the electric fan to face forward when it is not aligned. Enable the swing function to direct the fan towards the front.
- 3. Wipe off any dirt from the motor shaft, apply a thin layer of sewing machine oil for protection.
- 4. Put the product in its original packaging and keep it in a place with low humidity.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Fault	Possible reason	Solutions	
Failure to operate	*The power adapter is not properly plugged into the power strip or wall outlet, or the electric fan jack is not fully engaged.	*Plug in and power up again.	
	*The front and rear guards are not properly installed or have deformed and interfered with the blades, or the blades are not properly installed.	*Realign and properly install the front and rear guards and blades.	
Abnormal noise during running	*The blades are not properly fitted onto the motor shaft. *The blades are not properly installed or have deformed and been in contact with the guard. *The blade set screw nuts are not tightened. *The front guard is not properly	*Properly fit the blades onto the motor shaft. *Make sure that the blades are not in contact with the guard. *Tighten the blade set screw nuts. *Align and secure the front and	
	installed.	rear guards with screws.
