# **Safety Precautions**

In order to prevent accidents or injury to the user, other people, and damage to property, please follow the instructions below

- The rust prevention paper located between the pan and the cast heater must be removed before using.
- The following chart indicates the degree of damage caused by wrong operation.

Indicates hazard that may cause death or severe injury.

Indicates hazard that may cause human injuries or property damage.

■ Classification of instructions that need to be strictly followed uses the following symbols to distinguish the instruction types.



These symbols mean prohibition.

These symbols mean requirement that must be followed.

#### Plug in tightly.



(Improper plugging may cause electric shock or fire due to heat generation.)

Do not use a damage plug or warped outlet.

#### Do not plug or unplug the appliance with wet hands.



(It may result in electric shock.)

Do not use wet hands

#### Do not place your hands or face over or near the steam vent.





(It may cause burning injuries.)

Do not damage the power cord or the power plug.

## **Usage Precautions**

### Avoiding damages to the appliance.


Do not cover the lid with a cloth.

The lid may become deformed, cracked or discolored and result in malfunction.

Do not place the appliance in direct sunlight.

Do not use the pan with other appliances,

Always keep the outside bottom of the pan and the cast heater clean and dry.



Always keep the outside bottom of the pan and the cast heater clean and dry. It may result in malfunction.

### Avoiding damages to the pan.

Do not leave the rice scoop or any other objects inside the pan.

The pan should be cleaned immediately after cooking with seasonings or condiments. Do not use the pan as mixing utility.

Do not use metal utensils that can scratch or

The coated surface of the pan will gradually wear away, so use with care.

Do not tap or rub the inner surface of the pan. Clean only with a sponge. (Do not use scouring pad.)

### **Cooking Rice**


Rinse the rice in a separate bowl until the water becomes relatively clear. Do not rinse the rice in the provided pan.

Adjust water level

Wash and rinse the rice with drinking water. When hot water is used to cook rice, it may result in discoloring and sogginess. 5 Stir cooked rice

When the water is completely evaporated, the rice is cooked. After at least 15 minutes, steam and mix rice well. Stir it to allow the moisture to swell the grains for the best tasting rice.

### How to cook


Measure rice with the measuring cup

Then rinse the rice thoroughly using other container.





Put the rinsed rice in the pan and add water according to the scales shown in the table below.



Correct

- Adjust the quantity of water to your personal taste.
- Soak rice in water at least 30 minutes for better rice cooking.

Place the pan into the body. Make sure the pan is directly in contact with the cast heater by turning it slightly from right to left until it settles properly.



■ Wipe the surface of the pan before use. If it is wet, it may cause noise while cooking. Any foreign matter between the pan and cast heater may damage the unit.


Close the lid firmly.

- If lid is not securely closed. cooking performance will be affected.
- Do not open the lid when in use.

Plug in and press the switch. The light indicating "COOK will be on. The cooking will start




- Do not plug in the unit until you are ready to cook. Otherwise, rice may be ruined.
- If the pan is not in the unit. cooking will not begin.
- After the switch pops up, leave the lid closed for at least 15 minutes to steam rice. Then mix the rice well by using the scoop to allow water vapor to escape.

Unplug the appliance when it is not in use.




### How to clean



#### **Cast Heater**

If an object has stuck on the cast heater, lightly polish it off using fine sandpaper (of about #600) / steel wool. Then wipe with a damp cloth.




